Directions to Raheen Na Gun;

From Clonmel rd... Keep left at rbt for town centre passing garage on your right. Pass Hotel Kilkenny and take 2nd turn on left immediately past the Skeilp Inn. Follow this road straight on past school on left and Garda Station on right. Straight on at large roundabout and then straight on at fried egg roundabout. Pass St Canices School on the right. Turn left then as the road turns right down Granges road. Raheen Na Gun is on the left about a quarter of a mile down.

From Freshford Road.

Pass St Lukes Hospital on left and turn right at fried egg roundabout(200mtrs before St James Park) . Then turn right again as road turns to the left ..Granges Road... . Raheen Na Gun is on the left about a quarter of a mile down.

From M9 Dublin

Take exit 8 off M9 onto N10 follow signs for Kilkenny until Toyota Garage in front of you on roundabout straight over at this roundabout passing cemetery on the right. Turn right at next roundabout in front of Nolan Park, take 2nd exit at Newpark Roundabout passing back of army barracks on your left. Straight on at next roundabout and over the river (Greens Bridge). Right at T junction (possibly signposted Hospital) past St James Park on your left and turn immediately left at fried egg rbt. Then turn right as road turns to the left ..Granges Road... . Raheen Na Gun is on the left about a quarter of a mile down.

From Castlecomer rd.

Pass Newpark Hotel on your left. Turn right at roundabout . and over the river (Greens Bridge). Right at T junction (possibly signposted Hospital) past St James Park on your left and turn immediately left at fried egg rbt. Then turn right as road turns to the left ..Granges Road... . Raheen Na Gun is on the left about a quarter of a mile down.
